You can use the App to let us know your child will be absent from school, contact staff members, read the latest newsletter, check the school calendar or the terms dates for next year, and see what's new on the class blogs. Once you have set your preferences you can also receive alerts about various things happening at school.

The App is another way for us to let you know very important information in a hurry – e.g. if we need to close the school for reasons such as snow or natural disasters, or if we need to open late because of plumbing or power issues. Please take a moment to download the App - or pop into the office for help if you are not sure about setting your preferences for alerts. We are happy to help.

Sunhats

Our Sun Smart policy requires all children to wear a Rāwhiti School sunhat in Terms 1 and 4. We are giving the children plenty of reminders this week, and were really impressed with the number of children who turned up on Monday with hat in hand. From the beginning of next week all children not wearing Rāwhiti hats will be required to sit under the covered area in front of the learning studios during break times. Our shade sails are going back up this week to provide further protection for children playing in the grounds.

School Zone

Details of the Rāwhiti School Enrolment Zone are all but finalised and are with the Ministry of Education for final sign off. It is highly likely that the zone will be in place from the beginning of the new school year.

If you live **in our school zone**, nothing will change for you. We do need to know if you have a pre-schooler due to start in 2017 so if you have not already done so please contact Jan in the office for the enrolment paperwork. The number of in-zone enrolments dictates how many out of zone places will be available.

If you live **outside of the school zone** and have a child due to start school in Term 1 of 2017 you will be part of a ballot that will happen as soon as the zone has been confirmed by the MoE.

- If you have <u>already completed a Rāwhiti enrolment form</u> Jan will contact you directly and send you a form specifically for the ballot.
- If you have <u>not yet enrolled your pre-schooler for term 1</u> you should see Jan in the school office <u>asap</u> to complete an Out of Zone Enrolment Form.
