This week we welcome two new Teacher Aides to our Support Staff team – Debbie O'Hara and Lizzie Peoples. We now have 13 amazing Teacher Aides supporting learning and behaviour across both bases, a great investment in our children's learning.

Rāwhiti School Travel Plan

In October last year we started working with the Christchurch City Council traffic engineers on a proposal that includes parking and crossing facilities outside our home base in Leaver Terrace. The BOT made a submission to the Community Board and we have been assured that both they and the CCC are committed to advocating for this to be included in the 2015-2025 LTP.

We are now working on the development of a School Travel Plan for Rāwhiti. School Travel Plans aim to support and encourage children to safely walk, bike, scooter or bus with their parents, caregivers or friends to and from school where possible. The plans include consideration of local road safety issues which may be affecting choices on how children travel to and from school.

Next week we will be emailing you the link to a short survey to gather data on how children will be travelling to and from our new site in 2016. Please do take the time to fill it in. Note that the Ministry of Education funded buses, currently providing daily transportation between bases, will not operate in 2016 – so now is a good time to start thinking about how your children will get to school.

We would also like to hear from any parents interested in being part of a working group with the Council Community Education Coordinator. Please let Jan in the office know if this is something you would be prepared to spend some time on to assist the school.

We are always open to hearing from school families regarding travel issues, especially ways to improve our children's wellbeing and safety.
