With so much happening on a weekly basis, and so much information we think it important to share, we have decided to publish a weekly newsletter for the rest of this term.

# Rāwhiti Daily Timetable

Our daily timetable will be new to many of you. This timetable has been chosen in the best interests of our children.

We know that an hour can be a very long time for a child to manage themselves in the playground, so shortening the breaks ensures that children are not spending a prolonged period of time looking for things to do. Because we are new, we are able to question many of the educational customs and assumptions schools have inherited over time. We do so to ensure we are setting our learners up for success – both in and out of the classroom.

# **Coming to School Too Early**

Please remember that our teachers need time before the children arrive each morning to finish setting up for the day and the time before 8:30am is precious to them. Children at school prior to 8.30am are not supervised. The exception to this is Breakfast Club, which runs on Tuesday and Thursday mornings – 8am on the QE2 Base and 8.15am on the Beach Base.

### **Coffee and Questions**

Today we had the first of our 'coffee and question' opportunities and this will be repeated next Thursday - before school on the Beach Base, and after school on the QE2 Base. Please take the opportunity to have a coffee and ask our Leadership Team any questions you may have.

# **School Donations**

The Board of Trustees has set the level of the school donation for 2015 at \$50 for one child and \$80 for a family. \$50 per child, across the school year, is the equivalent of \$1.25 per week, or just 25 cents per school day.
