#### **School Uniform**

Please make sure your child is wearing the correct school uniform each day. Even though our current uniform is just for this year it is important that our children look like they belong at Rāwhiti School. Please note that:

- Children can wear **long-sleeved black or white thermal tops** under the school-t-shirts. Stripes, spots, and any other colours are not part of the interim uniform.
- Children can wear plain (e.g., no logos or lace), black lower-half items, including trousers, shorts, tights and skirts. Jeans are not permitted.
- During the winter terms students may wear a black beanie hat for warmth. Hats are not to be worn inside.
- Hair should be kept clean, neat and tidy, and away from the face. Shoulder length hair must be tied back in a tidy manner by a hair tie or similar.
- Make-up is not permitted.
