From The Principal - Te Pū kāea a te Tumuaki

Kia ora koutou, We have successfully made it to the end of what has been a rather disrupted term. I admire our tamariki, whānau and staff who have been able to "pivot" and adjust to the "new normal". We are increasingly amazed at the resilience of our tamariki.

Despite the disruption, our awesome PTA managed to achieve \$919.20 worth of Scholastic Books rewards from the Book Fair. Thank you very much to both the volunteers and the shoppers over the 2 days that the fair was open - the reward points will purchase a significant number of new books for our school library. We'll make sure that we showcase the new books in the newsletter once they arrive.

Term 4 swings into action with the Year 7 & 8 camp at Wainui. There are just 8 and a half weeks in Term 4, with two public holidays in the mix - Labour Day on Monday October 25th and the Canterbury Anniversary 'Show Day' on Friday November 12th. Rāwhiti School is also closed on Thursday November 11th for a Teacher Only Day. These dates have been in the calendar for the last two terms, but please add them to your diary now as we know the weeks start to race by the closer we get to the end of the year.

Cohort Entry

At its meeting last week the Board of Trustees adopted a Cohort Entry Policy for new entrant children, which will come into effect from the beginning of the 2022 school year. Cohort entry means

that children who have recently turned five begin school together in small groups. At Rāwhiti School there will be two cohort entries per term: one at the beginning of term, the other midway through the term. Children can remain at their ECE until the intake after their fifth birthday and they will continue to receive funding to attend ECE until they start school.

We appreciate the feedback given via the community survey and the BOT considered all of the points raised. 75% of parents who responded to the survey were in support of cohort entry, as were 100% of the early childhood centres.

If you have a 5 year already enrolled to start at Rāwhiti in Term 1 of 2022 our admin team will be in touch with you directly with information about your child's start date. If you have a child due to start next year and have not yet enrolled them, details of your child's start date/cohort will be provided when you complete the enrolment paperwork. Our school website will also be updated so that the start dates and other information about cohort entry is always available to you.

Property Projects

We have two projects due to get underway in the next 2 weeks. The front fence of the school is due to be replaced, with gates being added to all of the entrances. The northern side of our building will also be fenced off to allow for outdoor learning spaces to be created at the rear of each learning studio. These spaces have been designed by Kamo Marsh, who are responsible for the design work on all of our other landscaping projects - so we know we are getting something very special. This is a 17 week project so we won't get to use these spaces until the new school year starts.

In the meantime, the field and bike track will still be in use - but be mindful of vehicles and contractors if you are using the school grounds outside of school hours.



Exciting news to end the term - baby Bonnie Grae O'Neil arrived earlier this week. We know all of the children (and teachers) in Papatūānuku are looking forward to meeting Bonnie sometime next term. In the meantime we send our congratulations to Brogan and Chris, and big brother Darcy.

Once again, thank you for the great support this term. I hope you manage to enjoy some of the lovely spring weather with your children these holidays.


