

End of Year Events

We know we are living in uncertain times. Already this year we have seen a number of school events cancelled - which always results in disappointment. While we are not yet sure what the 'traffic light' system entails for schools we have made some decisions about end of year events to give you all some clarity for the next few weeks.

- **Children's University Graduation** is going ahead on Tuesday Nov 30th for graduating students and invited guests only.
- Parent Helpers Drinks Dec 2nd Cancelled.
- Year 8 Formal is going ahead final details being determined.
- **Rāwhiti Rumbustification Da**y Friday Dec 10th is going ahead. This day is for Rāwhiti children only parents and siblings are not able to attend.
- **Showcase Assembly** Monday Dec 13th is going ahead for Rāwhiti children only. This event will be recorded so that whānau can see the performances.
- Leavers Assembly Tuesday December 14th (6.30pm) is going ahead for Year 8 students, their invited guests and staff, with a live streaming option for other members of our community. Details will be coming out to Year 8 students and whānau next week.
- Porporoaki Wednesday December 15th 11am. Decision pending.

New Fences and Gates

The Ministry of Education has funded the new boundary fences and gates to ensure that we are able to keep our vulnerable children safely on the grounds. Some children will find the height of the gates somewhat challenging and will need assistance. While we are very happy for parents to help children in the mornings by opening the gate to let them in, please do not prop the gate open, or open the gate for children who are trying to get out!

Parent Helpers

If you wish to be able to provide parent help in your child's Learning Studio, support with any upcoming end of year trips, go on school camps in 2022, or be a parent helper in any capacity, we need to see evidence that you are fully vaccinated. The office will take a copy of your vaccine passport (or other proof of vaccination) and you will be added to our confidential vaccination register. The expiry date of your vaccination passport will be recorded.

All schools are obliged to follow the government mandated guidelines and we are mindful of our roll in supporting the nation's Covid response. To be clear, the Health Order does not require parents to be fully vaccinated when they are on site for the purposes of 'being a parent'.

With the new 'Traffic Light' system due to be introduced next week, some of the current requirements may change and we will keep you informed of the most up to date requirements.





Emotionally Intelligent Parenting

Tuning in to Kids is an evidence-based programme designed to teach parents & caregivers:

- How to coach a child through periods of heightened emotion resulting in emotional regulation
- Awareness of their children's emotions
- To use children's emotional experiences as an opportunity for closeness and teaching
- Skills in assisting children to verbally label and manage their emotions
- Skills in assisting children to problem solve
- To guide children's behaviour with appropriate limits

Sessions include:

- Watching video material
- Group discussions and exercises
- Role plays
- Home-based activities to practice different ways of responding to your child's emotions

Parents are encouraged to share experiences and ideas within the group


